Deer Resistant Perennials

Living in a woodland environment often means dealing with foraging deer. If you are having this problem in your landscape, try using some of these deer-resistant plants. Please note that no plant can be guaranteed deer-proof. When hungry enough, deer eat plants they normally pass by.
