Drought-Tolerant Woody Plants

If you have a spot that is hard to keep wet in summer, why fight nature? Use plants that thrive in dry conditions! The ecologically-friendly practice of planting drought-tolerant species that do not require irrigation (after the first year) is called *xeriscaping*. Using these plants helps to cut down summertime water use, saving you time, money and frustration.
